## Old Business

**Per Capita Tax** – The Supervisors are still considering a plan to replace the per capita tax.

New notes were included in the packet.

**Application for County Aid** – County Liquid Fuels Tax Funds Application needs to be signed by the Supervisors.

The application has been submitted.

**ARPA Application** – All along we were told we would not have to apply for the American Rescue Plan Act funds. That changed on June 1. At first, we were given 5 days to apply so on June 4 our application was submitted. At this time our application is still under review. Once they received them the state was given 30 days to pass the ARPA funds to the municipalities. The state received them on May 28th. The last I heard the Governor was asking for an extension of that 30 days.

## New Business

**T-tag funds** – An explanation of Liquid Fuels Major Equipment purchase dollars was presented. We have \$100,000 dollars available to purchase a T-Tag truck. Karl is working with a couple dealers to acquire prices.

**Banking** – The secretary would like to move our funds over to Northumberland National Bank. She would like to start with the ARPA funds when we receive them. Ending with the Payroll account when the current supply of checks is depleted. Authorized Check signers for Northumberland National Bank will be Treasurer Kathryn A Shea, Supervisor Gregory W Snook, Supervisor Karl T Zerbe, Supervisor Marvin L Eicher. Supervisor Karl Zerbe made a motion to start opening accounts in Northumberland National Bank. Supervisor Eicher seconded the motion. Motion carried.

**Meeting Date Change** – The July 15<sup>th</sup> date does not work for Supervisor Zerbe. It was requested to move the meeting to July 22, 2021. After checking with Greg Snook. The secretary will advertise a change of date in the Snyder County Times.

**Reviewed Letters:**

**Pennsylvania Compensation Rating Bureau** – They are going to audit the accuracy of the policy information filed by our workers compensation insurer (Penn National Mutual Casualty). The audit will be conducted by phone on 7/1/2021 at 11:00 am.

**William Houser Email** – SEDA-COG is offering assistance and expert guidance with ARPA funds. They attached a brief survey for municipalities who think they may need assistance.
